MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Everyone has a cancer story. People we love are diagnosed with cancer and we accompany them on their demanding, often devastating journey. No matter your gender, race, religion, socio-economic status or any other demographic, none of us is immune. We all have been touched by this unforgiving disease. And we are forever changed by the experience.

- Donors like you contributed \$3,247,958! THANK YOU!
- A Gateway funded trial (Cutler, 2013) treating chronic graft vs. host disease (GVHD) with rituximab (a monoclonal antibody), introduced an innovative new way to reduce GVHD. After four years, the treated group's survival rate was significantly better when compared to conventional treatments (71% vs. 56%).
- Researchers created a DNA vaccine targeting a breast cancer antigen which was demonstrated to be safe and to increase patients' immune response. The study also concluded that once patients completed conventional therapies, the vaccine could possibly stimulate the immune system to target and attack remaining or new cancer cells (Gillanders, 2014).
- A Gateway funded study was one of the first to use inhalation therapy to deliver molecular therapy directly to metastatic lung cancer.

We are proud of the research that Gateway has made possible over the past 25 years. And we have so much more to do to realize our Vision of shaping a world in which a cancer diagnosis is no longer feared.

PATIENT IMPACT Story

SHINING A LIGHT ON DEADLY CANCER

When Wesley McDermott was just six months old, he was diagnosed with Atypical Teratoid Rhabdoid Tumor (AT/RT), a rare brain tumor usually diagnosed in childhood. Within two days of surgery, Wesley's mother Samantha (pictured above) was told her son had brain cancer and given a grim prognosis.

An unbelievably happy little boy, Wesley has a perpetual smile, melting the hearts of even the toughest clinical staff. His smile is his mother's greatest joy. He has spent a substantial amount of his young life at Seattle Children's Hospital, undergoing treatment and joining an innovative Gateway-funded clinical trial led by Dr. Sarah Leary.

Dr. Leary's trial involves the use of a promising new discovery called Tumor Paint. What is Tumor Paint? It is a protein-linked dye made from the venom of an Israeli scorpion that finds and attaches itself to tumor tissue, illuminating the tissue under fluorescent light so surgeons can precisely target the tumor and remove it completely. Tumor Paint may be especially beneficial for patients whose tumor tissue might otherwise be difficult for surgeons to see with the naked eye.

Research findings from the Tumor Paint study are encouraging. Tumor Paint appears to work very well for use in children, and this "molecular flashlight" has the potential to revolutionize the way surgery for tumors is done. Given its early promise, researchers are in the process of planning a larger multi-institutional trial to take Tumor Paint all the way to the FDA, which will be a true first in pediatric brain cancer.

Wesley is a testament to miracles happening every day, and is continuing his courageous fight against cancer. Samantha's dream for the future is for Wesley to be happy, and she refuses to let cancer define their future.

A beautiful, brave little boy, Wesley inspires us to continue our critical mission of finding treatments and cures for cancer, so children like him do not have to face the same difficult struggles. We are honored to be part of Wesley's journey. He is his mother's hero, always. And ours.

The 2016 Conquer Cancer Foundation of ASCO/Gateway for Cancer Research Young Investigator Award was presented to Dr. Connie Batlevi in June at the Conquer Cancer Foundation (CCF) Grants and Awards Ceremony in Chicago.

Dr. Batlevi is a researcher at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, and is focused on the development of novel therapies for patients with lymphoma. Dr. Batlevi is the recipient of a grant co-funded by Gateway and Conquer Cancer Foundation of ASCO, and will study the safety of CD19 chimeric antigen receptor (CAR) T cells in transplant ineligible patients with diffuse large B cell lymphoma. Gateway's President, Teresa Hall Bartels, Gateway's Director of Research and Grants, Dr. Domarina Oshana, and Gateway's Midwestern Regional Development Officer, Walter Grandberry attended the award ceremony in June. "We are pleased to award Dr. Batlevi with this prestigious award, recognizing her outstanding commitment to innovative research and helping us conquer cancer," said Teresa Bartels. "We are equally pleased to partner with the Conquer Cancer Foundation. We share a sense of urgency to encourage and support Young Investigators."

GATEWAY FUNDED TRIALS

Gateway has funded over 140 breakthrough clinical trials around the world!^{iv}





Breast Cancer: A Gateway funded trial was the first to use the combination of Trastuzumab^v and HER2/neu-Specific vaccination in patients with metastatic breast cancer. This combination was found to be associated with minimal toxicity and resulted in prolonged, robust, antigen-specific immune responses intreated patients (Disis, 2009^{vi}).





Ovarian Cancer: Researchers created an innovative direct delivery of gene therapy to the fluid that surrounds cancerous ovaries with tolerable side effects for patients, which was pioneering for its time and could affect future gene therapy research (Curiel, 2000^{ix}).





Sarcoma: Researchers combined the dendritic cell vaccine with a specific radiation therapy to enhance the performance of immune system therapy for sarcoma patients. The findings showed a dramatic increase in T-cell levels within the tumors and 70 percent of patients were progression-free after one year (Gabrilovich, 2012[×]).
